- Prescriptions
- Over the counter medications
- Medication samples
- Medications for pets
- Ointments and lotions
- Vitamins and supplements
- Liquid medication (please place sealed container in a ziplock bag)

NO NOT ACCEPTED

- Needles, sharps or syringes
- Thermometers
- Blood or infections waste
- Medications from businesses or clinics
- Hydrogen peroxide
- Aerosol cans or inhalers
- Food items
